Are you ready for some BMW CCA changes??? Okay so you have heard it before, and it is back again. Changes, changes and a few more changes... Here are a few things: **BMW CCA Dues increase September 1st**. It is a \$10 a year increase over current prices. Beginning September, a 1 year membership: \$58.00; 3 year membership: \$165.00; and a 5 year membership is now \$270.00. You can renew your membership under the current lower rates before September 1. The 2 year membership is no longer available. The associate membership (person in same household) remains at \$10.00 a year. And THIS JUST IN: It will not happen on the posted date, but later in the year or in 2020? AS soon as they (National) can improve the process, so that it can make it a smooth transition for the members to renew, the membership dues rate increase will go into effect.

<u>Chapter NEWSLETTERS</u>: They (National BOD) have decided to change the idea of a Quarterly regional newsletter in favor for a biannual "*BimmerLife*" a 'super premium' regional magazine. (this portion has been partially copied from an Email from SAR-VP to the SAR – Chapter Presidents). Claimed to be the largest car show in the Southeast, the monthly Cars & Coffee Palm Beach (at the oulet mall on Palm Beach Lakes

Blvd., just east of I-95) continues to grow, hitting over 2,000 cars, with a large contingent of BMWs, from as far south as Miami, and a large group from Orlando.

The show has a heavy bent on modern cars, unlike most shows with 50-70s American classics. It is also a decidedly younger crowd, drawn to the large number of supercars and show cars.

How Do I find Out About the Chapter Events?
