



## Editor's Corner by Michael J Posner

My open letter to Mike Miller the Tech Talk columnist at Roundel:

My 2013 M6 has burned about 1 quart of oil every 650-700 miles since purchased used at 32k miles. BMW insists this is normal. After continued complaining they gave me SI B11 03 13 (tinyurl.com/ycw6oes3) and also told me that they have a new procedure:

"Procedure: Engine oil - Topping up - When one of the above vehicles displays a message to add 1 quart of engine oil, BMW recommends adding 2 quarts of engine oil instead. The engine's oil sump design allows the additional quart; the result is a total capacity of 9.5 quarts (9.0 liters) of engine oil."

Following this I get about 1350 or so miles before the warning. However, since then I have lost a valve cover gasket and an air mas meter (which the tech said was covered in oil residue). Coincidence? Car now has 55k miles, and drives fine otherwise. Thoughts?



Mike Miller responded, "If you are using something else, switch to Lubri-Moly or Red Line 10W-60 engine oil. This engine does not like low viscosity engine oil, and the BMW oil tends to test out "finished" upon oil analysis at 4,000-5,000 miles. Reduce oil and filter change intervals to every 5,000 miles using one of these two products, and have analysis performed: www.blackstone-labs.com. That said, BMW considers one liter engine oil consumption every 500 miles to be normal in M cars. I disagree."

I am due for an oil change this summer, so I will switch to Red Line and see if that makes a big difference in the oil

burning. Having Mike Miller as a club asset is fantastic and I follow his answers in Roundel every issue. My M6 has become homesick for the dealer...three service calls in 1500 miles, first a valve cover gasket, then the air mass meter and now a faulty driver's seat. Glad I purchased that extended warranty, I am sure with the third repair I would be in the red (especially at Braman's \$256 per hour charge for M car repairs). With only seven months left of coverage I am getting nervous, should I get another warranty or bite the bullet and buy a newer BMW.


