Associate members will receive a postcard in the mail, giving them a unique identifier to use when casting their ballots.

Only members in good standing as of December 15, 2009, may vote in this election. Voting will open on Monday January 4, 2010, and close February 26, 2010, at noon Eastern Time. Results will be posted on the Club website that same day at 5:00 p.m. ET.
